pieces, Collins helped drill them together to build a wheelchair ramp at the home of a disabled Killeen resident.

Collins, 12, was among 52 out-of-town church volunteers who arrived at First United Methodist Church of Killeen on Sunday. The group, from Lake Cities United Methodist Church in Dallas, First United Methodist Church in Mesquite and Trinity United Methodist Church in Arlington, worked Monday through Thursday to finish up projects at five sites in the Killeen area, including repairing flooring and roofing, painting and building wheelchair ramps.

"My friends are always talking about how fun mission trips are and I thought it would be fun to help people and have fun at the same time," said Collins, adding it was her first mission trip. "I'm definitely going to come back. I really enjoy helping people because I like feeling that humbleness "


